NTSE is a national-level scholarship exam organized by NCERT for students in the 10th standard. It



is conducted in two stages, stage 1 by the state board, and stage 2 is conducted by NCERT. The exam involves two papers, MAT (Mental Ability Test) which is a test of logical reasoning, and SAT (Scholastic Aptitude Test) which includes math, science, and social studies.

"I started my preparation for this exam towards the end of the ninth grade under the guidance of my teachers, especially my math teacher who motivated me to

work hard and do my best. The exam tests the total syllabi of classes 9 and 10 at a more competitive level, thus it needed rigorous practice on a regular basis.

Due to the pandemic, the exam dates were delayed and rescheduled a couple of times for both stages 1 and 2. In the stage 1 exam, I was able to secure state 3<sup>rd</sup> rank in Telangana, out of 216 shortlisted candidates. In the stage 2 exam, results of which were declared recently, I was able to secure the NTS scholarship along with a total of 2033 national scholars.

Preparing for this exam gave me the opportunity to build and strengthen my foundation for future competitive examinations like KVPY, Olympiads, and JEE."
