

CLASS IV – INTER HOUSE ACTIVITY - STORY MAPPING

A story map is a strategy that uses a graphic organizer that helps students learn the elements of a book or story. By identifying story characters, plot, setting, problem and solution, students read carefully to learn the details. It is used during and after reading a text. This strategy supports students' comprehension by providing students with a framework for identifying and organizing details about a story.

Story mapping has helped improve students to comprehend, identifying the elements of the story, varying the abilities and to organize information and ideas efficiently. Students made a story map in which they mentioned characters which include people, animals, creatures and things, settings like where and when the story has taken place, plot like what are the problems in the story and how were the problems solved etc. Students drew different shapes and colored.
