REPORT ON INTER HOUSE QUIZ CONTEST

STD VII

Date: 27th Oct, 2016

“Knowledge is of no value unless you put it into practice” — Chekhov

Keeping this adage in mind and with the objective of improving general knowledge of students, an Inter House Quiz Contest for class VII was held on 27th Oct, 2016 in room no.14.



The contest was conducted in two rounds. The preliminary round was conducted in individual classes and all the students mandatorily appeared for the same. This



was a written round of twenty questions based on a number of topics like General Science, Sports, Space Technology, Geography, current Affairs etc. From every section, the top scorer of each house was

selected for final round. Then the students of one house were divided into two teams where each team comprised of four students.

The final round was held in room no.14 with the help of a PowerPoint presentation. The eight teams identified after the preliminary round were given interesting names after the indigenously designed missiles of India like 'BRAHMOS', 'AGNI', 'PRITHVI', 'DHANUSH', 'TRISHUL' etc. pertaining to the event.

The quizmaster Ms. Asima conducted the quiz with the help of Ms. Sunitha who helped in keeping track of the score. Head Mistress Ms. Pallavi graced the occasion. The quiz consisted of five rounds. Each round was prefaced by a slide depicting rules of that round.



First round called '**Take Your Pick**' had a choice of eight different topics. Team leaders of all the teams were called together to pick up a chit having a topic written in the same. Each team was asked two questions based on the topic they picked up. The second round '**Double Dip**' was a round with two choices where

marks were allotted according to the number of choices taken by the team. Third round was a visual round named '**Pick A Boo**' where each team was shown a photograph of a famous personality with the face hidden. Students were asked to guess the name based on the clue



shown along with the photograph. As the round was passable to the next team, each team tried their best to get the answer.



Fourth round named **'What You See Is What You Get'** was a picture round where a picture was displayed on screen for one minute. Based on the picture, questions were asked. Since this was a buzzer round there was tremendous excitement amongst the participants. Few questions were thrown to audience also. Few teams went way ahead in this round as they were quick to answer.

Final round **'Mixed Bag'** also was a buzzer round with negative mark attached. Teams were very careful as none of them wanted to risk their score. At the end of this round **Team A (BRAHMOS) of Topaz house** emerged as winner with 180 points and **Team A (PRITHVI) of Ruby house** bagged the 2nd position with 140 points. The third position was bagged by **Team B (AMOGHA) of Emerald House** with 125 points.

While the above rounds were going on, the audience also took keen interest in answering the questions which were passed on to them. In general, lot of excitement and curiosity was observed amongst all students regarding the event and participants gave their best effort to compete with the other groups and secure the top position. The event concluded on a high note with participants expressing their willingness to take part in more such events.
