Show and tell is a key part of the school day and an important part of a child's learning development, as it helps them to organize information and builds their confidence.

It's also a great way to encourage a child's interest in a particular

topic and - as almost anything goes - it's a chance for children to think 'outside the box' a little and invite their teacher and classmates to come into their own little world for a minute or two.

A generic topic was given to the class and the child was free to choose an item of his/her choice to speak about. It also could have been a topic supported by prop with the child's dialogue about it being the main focus of attention.

This activity helps children to be confident in public speaking. Some children love to take the centre stage at school and are confident at speaking in front of their class, other children may struggle with shyness and nervous, making them unwilling to participate in public speaking. Keeping this in mind DPS Hyderabad conducts show and tell contests at very young age to help their students from that inhibitions.

The topic was 'my favourite cartoon' character for the first round. Four children were selected from each section to compete during final round. The topic was "my favourite festival" for the final round. Children spoke about different festivals of their like including national festivals. The judges were very happy to see the confidence in the students. There are total seven winners of this contest.
